Why the houses?

Centacare Evolve Housing is the largest Community Housing provider in Tasmania. Building homes for people on the housing waiting list is a key priority for us. We know the impact of having a home has on people's wellbeing.

This year for homelessness week we worked with schools, disability and local community groups to decorate the houses to raise awareness about people experiencing homelessness, create an understanding of the supports that exist, and improve understanding about Community Housing.



What is YIMBY?

The YIMBY (Yes In My Backyard) movement was created in response to the NIMBY (Not In My Backyard) response. Centacare Evolve Housing's YIMBY movement is an education campaign focused on; Creating and providing informative about community housing – what it is, what services we provide and who live in them; listening and openly discussing the impact housing will have in local areas; collaborating with local communities for wellbeing and integration of tenants and residents; and continue advocating for inclusive housing policies and strategy within government and LGAs.
